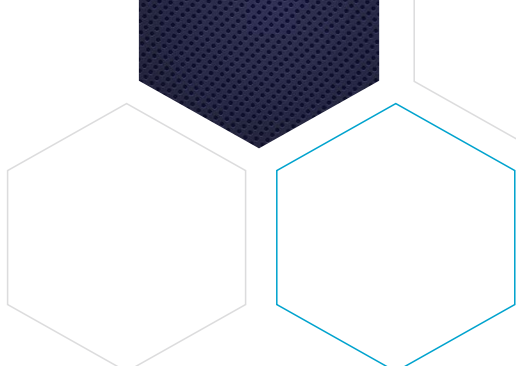

Decisions and Disruptions is an immersive game that puts you in the front seat of a power plant and allows you to make critical decisions on your plant's security with the help of your fellow board members.

You will be called upon to make vital decisions on what to spend your money on each quarter. But like all decisions, it isn't always going to be plain sailing and you might find yourself with a disruption that you need to fix before it affects your business.

The game uses Lego bricks to make the experience more interactive and to allow you to be hands on.

It is geared towards key decision makers within a business, however, is also a good opportunity to involve all staff so they are aware of the impact cyber crime can have on everyone and the steps needed to counteract such threats.

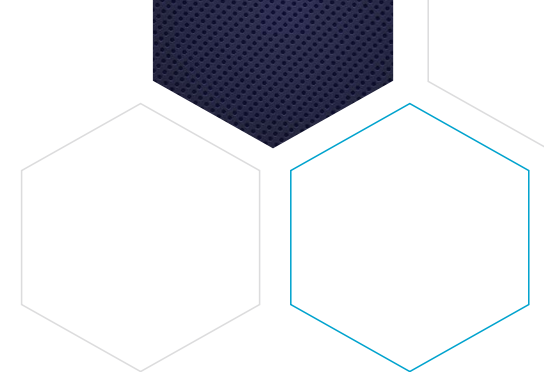
